WELCOME TO FRANCE

First in France!

Le Grand Bornand hosts a World Cup biathlon competition on French soil for the first time. It promises to be a historic event at a time when this particular sport is rapidly gaining popularity in France, greatly due to the success of the French athletes at the 2010 Vancouver Olympics.

Having won 6 Olympic medals in Vancouver, amongst a total of 11 overall, the French biathletes, Vincent Jay, reigning Olympic Champion, Martin Fourcade, Marie Laure Brunet, Marie Dorin-Habert, Sandrine Bailly and our local sportswoman, Sylvie Becaert, created a real buzz amongst the crowds of spectators and television viewers. The games were a great success for the French team, skiing in the tail winds of Raphael Poirée, 8 times World Champion, Florence Baverel and Vincent Dufrasne, Olympic Champions in Turin 2006.

First in the World!

A champion breeding ground, with no less than 8 athletes present at the Vancouver Olympics, Le Grand Bornand counts 11 athletes on the international circuit this season. This pretty ski resort in the Haute-Savoie region has been chosen by the French Ski Federation (FFS) and the International Biathlon Union (IBU) to host 2 World Cup Biathlon events, in 2011 and 2013.

An adventure that promises to be fruitful after the successful "trial shoot" last March for the IBU Cup, when 10 000 spectators created "THE" event on the European biathlon circuit! This is the first event on the World circuit to take place at the heart of a village. A new page in French sports history ... a World Cup event "à la maison"!

The duo, Annecy-Grand Bornand, successful organizers of events such as the Tour de France, European ski competitions, the Lakeside Festival or the biggest kids festival "Au Bonheur des Mômes", wish to involve the general public as much as possible, to promote both the sport and its champions.

A party in the offing

To celebrate the event and in an attempt to satisfy the increasing popularity of this sport in France, the resort will organize concerts, entertainment and introductory Biathlon sessions. This event is seen as an opportunity for the resort to establish itself as a biathlon reference on the world circuit and an occasion to rediscover the incredible facilities that possess Annecy and Le Grand Bornand. Travel from one site to the next, between lake and mountains, in less than an hour!

UNITED IN FORCE

The organization of this World Cup biathlon event in France is a result of common volition between Anancy and Le Grand Bornand, to create an event backed by the French Ski Federation.

Great organization skills

Anancy and Le Grand Bornand have previously demonstrated their capacity to organize a number of international ski competitions. Last March, the duo successfully hosted the finals of the European Cup (IBU cup). In 2010, Anancy organized an international athletics meeting that brought in crowds of more than 12 000 spectators. In the field of skiing, Le Grand Bornand successfully organized the first ever Handiski World Championships, the European Biathlon Championships in 1995, the final of the European Alpine Cup in 2003 and more recently, the French Cross-Country and Biathlon Championships in 2006 and 2007 that gathered crowds of more than 9000 spectators over a 2 day period.

WHAT'S ON THE PROGRAMME ?

First ever World Cup event to take place at the heart of a village!

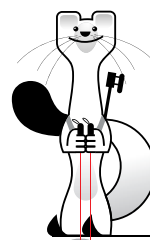
220 of the world's male and female specialists will race in the individual, sprint, pursuit and mixed relay events to take place in the new stadium. Contrary to other events on the World circuit, the competition stadium in Le Grand Bornand is situated at the heart of the village, close to the local population.

The aim: To promote world class sport and create a festive atmosphere amongst the general public. A challenge previously met last March at the finals of the European Cup (IBU Cup) organized by Le Grand Bornand, when more than 10 000 spectators gathered in mass. A first-time experience on the European circuit!

A MULTI-PURPOSE INTERNATIONAL STADIUM

Only several hundred metres from the heart of the resort, the Olympic stadium in Le Grand Bornand is ideally situated at an altitude of 1000 metres.

In accordance with a strict programme for sustainable development, the new stadium is used for a series of different events throughout the year: Tour de France, paragliding landing spot, festivals etc.



TECHNICAL CHARACTERISTICS AND INTERNATIONAL STANDARDS

An exclusive «A» licence

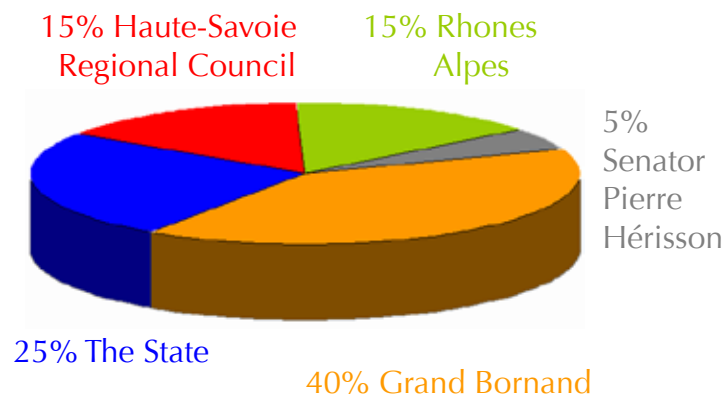
To organize Olympic and world class events, the stadium in Le Grand Bornand had to obtain an A licence, delivered by the International Biathlon Union (IBU).

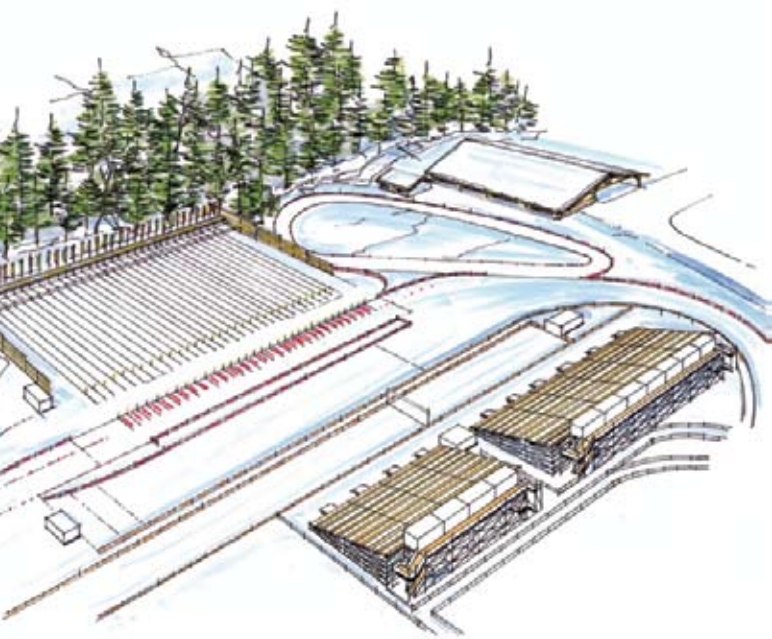
The facilities? A 30 target shooting range, a penalty circuit, open and compact cross-country slopes, an arrival and departure zone together with an area for spectators. The cost? A 4 million euro investment partially financed by the resort itself and the remainder by a number of economic and institutional parties: the state, the region, the Regional Assembly, the Haute Savoie Regional Council and the French Ski Federation.

An eco-friendly adventure

The Biathlon stadium perfectly integrates the surrounding natural environment. The equipment and landscaping of the stadium is particularly respectful of local heritage and the natural beauty of the site. Situated within the perimeter of a Heritage Centre the stadium was built in collaboration with the National Association of Architects. The shooting wall is made of local stone in an attempt to preserve the authentic character of the site.

In order to remain a competitive ski resort and successfully preserve alpine agriculture and mountain pastures, le Grand Bornand has long been campaigning for the application of eco-friendly politics.





A PROJECT CONFORM TO A PROGRAMME FOR SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT

- 80% of the facilities will be removed after the competition. Bridges and stands will be dismantled.
- The stands are those previously used in Annecy for the lakeside festival.
- The existing congress hall will host the press and VIPs and the ice rink will accommodate the logistics team.
- The slopes to be used for the race are already existent and designed to preserve the natural and agricultural surroundings.

AN ECO-FRIENDLY ATTITUDE

- During the competitions, a shuttle bus service will run from Thônes.
- Use of vehicles will be limited. Access to the competition ground will only be authorized by shuttle bus or on foot.
- Recycling waste containers will be installed on site and recyclable plates and cups will be used throughout the events.

3 QUESTIONS FOR SYLVIE BECAERT, WORLD CHAMPION BIATHLETE FROM LE GRAND BORNAND

World Cup and World Champion sprinter in 2003, Olympic medallist in Turin and Vancouver and World Champion in the mixed relay in 2009, Sylvie Becaert took retirement after the Canadian Olympics. In tribute to her excellent sporting achievements, Le Grand Bornand decided to dedicate its new stadium to her. Ambassador of the competition, she will ensure the representation of the different athletes during the 2 World Cup events to be held in resort between now and 2013.

This new and unique French stadium is dedicated to you, how do you feel about this?

"Other famous French athletes like Laurent Jalabert or Stéphane Diagana have made sporting history and I am extremely proud of the fact that my name be associated with a Biathlon stadium in Le Grand Bornand. I'm honoured.

Last March, during the IBU Cup, there was a great deal of emotion when I watched the young athletes succeed here. I can't quite imagine how I will feel when I see my ex team mates on track. I hope that my stadium, the first in its kind in France, will bring them all the luck they need!"

What will be your role in the organization of these World Cup events?

I will be representing the different athletes and providing the organization with my extensive sporting experience. I am able to explain what is important to athletes both on site and in local hotels. Athletes are away from home for several consecutive weeks and mustn't lose nerve impulse in the every day routine. In the stadium, everything must facilitate the athletes, whatever the weather. I am here to ensure that the sportsmen and women that compete in Le Grand Bornand all leave with a happy memory of this 1st French World Cup event.



Will you be as stressed as when you were competing?

"I am very relaxed. The Grand Bornand has already proved its capability during the IBU Cup. In a simple and authentic manner, we will do everything that we possibly can to ensure that the athletes, IBU officials, media, volunteers, the organization and general public take home a memorable souvenir".



A WORLD CUP ATMOSPHERE

Over this 4 day period, a festive atmosphere will gain the entire resort.

Around the stadium...

3000 seats in the stands and an arrival area large enough to host 5000 people will enable spectators to catch the entire event. Better still; the crowds can follow the racing on giant screens with live commentary from the speaker.

...and in the rest of resort

The marquees in place close to the stadium will host the pre-event parties and continue to do so for the official ceremonies. A festive and friendly atmosphere will gain the entire resort. On the programme: concerts and bands in every corner of the resort, in the local bars and restaurants. The highlight of festivities: an evening in the presence of all the individual medalists on the Saturday.

In search of volunteers

500 people volunteered to help at the finals of the IBU Cup last March. These volunteers play an important part in the organization of a major sporting event and are absolutely essential to the success of this World Cup.

Once again, the Organization Committee wishes to mobilize the entire region, seeking voluntary help from the local town Mayors. Stadium staff, VIP officials, ticket sales...the jobs available to voluntary workers are numerous. Our aim is to create a dynamic group and share a rich human experience around the organization of a great international event. Les Contamines-Montjoie, Evian, Manigod and Entremont are amongst the resorts that have already volunteered to help.



DID YOU KNOW ?

The length of television coverage has multiplied by 6 between 1999 and 2011, partly due to the success of our biathletes at the Vancouver Olympics.

Transmission time has increased from 260 hours per annum in 1999 to 1700 hours today.

+500 million: the audience has grown enormously too, rising from 214 million to 773 millions in twelve years.

11 champions fly the local colours

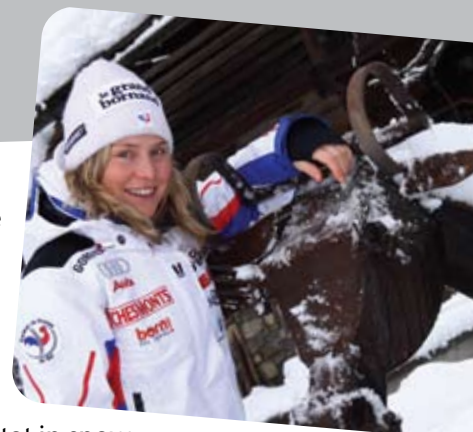

This year they are joined by three young talented skiers, Bastien Midol in ski cross, Pierre Mazouat in snowboard and Antoine Blanchi in freestyle.

Encouraged by the locals...

Created in 2006, the fan club in Le Grand Bornand boasts more than 1500 members, approximately one in two residents!

For the past five years fans have travelled to different World Cup races to support their local champions. More than 800 club bobble hats have already been sold to encourage the local athletes. This year, the fashion will be a fan club Chapka!

LE GRAND BORNAND : A VAST SKI AREA

Only an hour from Geneva and 30 minutes from Lake Annecy, at the heart of the Aravis mountain range and dominated by the summit of "Point Percée" at 2750m, Le Grand Bornand is a concentration of pure alpine pleasure, reputed for its alpine and Nordic ski areas.

Nordic ski facilities:

- A Nordic area within the village: 3, 5, 10, 15 and 20 kilometre circuits departing from the village in direction of the Bouchet Valley are equipped for skaters and classic cross-country skiers alike.
- A 14 km Nordic link between Le Grand Bornand and La Clusaz (return)
- A 12 km skating circuit in the Bouchet Valley.
- A permanent biathlon stadium (cross-country & skating) in the Bouchet Valley.
- 10 kilometres equipped with artificial snow making facilities.
- Nordic facilities at Chinaillon: A choice of 2, 5, 8 and 12 kilometre circuits departing from the old village. Groomed for classic cross-country only.

FACT & FIGURES

- 43 kilometres of Nordic trails
- 90 kilometres of downhill runs
- 29 ski lifts (2 cable cars)
- 22 kilometres of slopes equipped with artificial snow making facilities

ONCE UPON A TIME...

Situated between the Aravis and Bornes mountain ranges, Le Grand Bornand lies at the junction of the Bouchet Valley, reputed for its Nordic domain and the Chinaillon Valley, renowned for its alpine skiing.

However, despite its sporting authentic. The river Borne lent its name to the village. Dominated by the "Pointe Percée" at 2752 metres altitude, Le Grand Bornand has successfully maintained its authenticity whilst simultaneously developing its tourist activity. The existence of exceptionally old chalets and farms add to the resorts irresistible charm. In order to preserve a traditional architectural aspect, all the rooftops in Le Grand Bornand are tiled in wood, the famous "tavaillons».



...in the land of reblochon cheese, and agro-pastoral activities!

If one has been able to ski here since 1907, one never forgets the importance of the agricultural and pastoral activities in a region where tourism and farming are closely related. The most important farming town in the region, Le Grand Bornand counts 2400 acres of agricultural land and as many cows as there are residents, more than 2000!

Home to quality controlled (A.O.C.) reblochon cheese since 1958, Le Grand Bornand and its 50 farms have produced this famous farmhouse cheese for hundreds of years. Only certain breeds of cow produce the kind of milk necessary for its manufacture. Here in Le Grand Bornand, tourists can visit a farm and learn everything there is to know about the cheese making process, from milking to tasting!

Popular in the famous Tartiflette dish, this farmhouse cheese, produced twice a day, can be found on some of the most renowned dinner tables. Reblochon cheese is also a theme for a gourmet escapade along the footpaths of the Aravis mountain range.

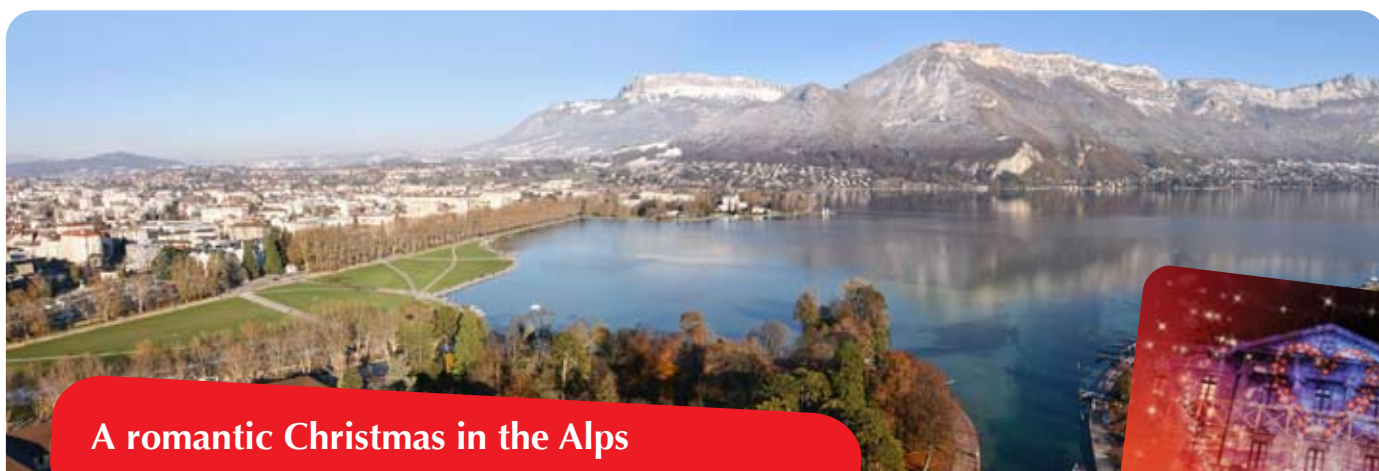
ANNECY, JEWEL OF THE ALPS

A historic and cultural town, Annecy is renowned for its scenic beauty, natural and architectural heritage and excellent quality of life!
